Internet Explorer Keyboard Shortcuts

ALT+D	Select the address bar.
ALT+END	Display the last page to be printed in Print Preview.
ALT+ENTER	Open search results in a new tab.
ALT+ENTER	Open the website address that is typed in the address bar in a new tab.
ALT+HOME	Go to home page.
ALT+LEFT or RIGHT ARROW	Go to the previous or next page.
ALT+U	In Print Preview, change headers, footers, paper type, orientation, and margins for current page.
CTRL+0 (Zero)	Zoom to 100%.
CTRL+A	Select all items on the current page.
CTRL+B	Open Organize Favorites dialog.
CTRL+D	Add current page to Favorites.
CTRL+DOWN ARROW	View list of available search providers.
CTRL+E	Opens Windows Live Search.
CTRL+ENTER	Add “http //www.” to the beginning and “.com” to the end of text in the address bar.
CTRL+F	Find a word or set of words on the current page.
CTRL+F5	Refresh the current page, overriding your cache.
CTRL+H	Open the History box.
CTRL+I	Opens Favorites.
CTRL+J	Open Feeds.
CTRL+LEFT ARROW	In the address bar, moves the cursor left to the next logical break (i.e. a period or slash)
CTRL+MINUS	Zoom out.
CTRL+N	Open the current page in a new window.
CTRL+P	Print the current page.
CTRL+PLUS	Zoom in.
CTRL+Q	Open Quick Tab view.
CTRL+SHIFT+H	Open History in pinned mode.
CTRL+SHIFT+I	Open Favorites in pinned mode.
CTRL+SHIFT+J	Open Feeds in pinned mode.
CTRL+SHIFT+Q	View list of open tabs.
CTRL+SHIFT+TAB	Switch to previous open tab.
CTRL+T	Open new tab.
CTRL+TAB	Switch to next open tab.
CTRL+W	Closes the browser window.
DOWN or UP ARROW	Scroll up or down the page.
ESC	Stop downloading current page.
F1	Displays IE Help.
F11	Toggle between full-screen view and regular view.
F4	View a list of previously typed addresses.
F5	Refresh current page.
HOME or END	Move to the beginning or end of the page.
TAB	Move forward through items on a web page, the Search Box, or the Address box.
